Message from the CEO



Dear Readers, Greetings!

We are delighted to present you progress highlights as of mid-March 2023 including a success story of our member in Bagmati Province and recent capacity building initiatives.

We present you the story of Ms. Sanu Maiya Sarki, our member from Thecho, Lalitpur in Bagmati Province who established herself as a successful entrepreneur engaging in bag industry. Under capacity building, highlights of

Global Money Week - GMW 2023 celebrations have been covered. With one event each in all of the seven provinces, we interacted with over 400 participants towards raising their level of financial literacy.

The disbursement under CSR and CP activities continued during the reporting period ~ 1,799 members received maternity allowance, 367 received critical illness relief and 214 received disaster relief, so far in this FY 2079/80. There has been no significant changes in our service coverage and outreach. However, number of centers (22,609), active clients (403,330) and loan clients (237,167) as of mid-March 2023, marked a slight increase during the reporting month.

The looming crises in MFI sector together with lopsided media coverage calls for credible data and research establishing the significant contribution of the sector towards poverty reduction and economic development together with women empowerment in the country. Nirdhan inputs are sought after by both national and international scholars and we have had the honor of welcoming some dignitaries recently. On 29 March, former Minister of Finance and Foreign Affairs of Nepal, Dr. Prakash Chandra Lohani interacted with us on inception and current status of MFIs in general and Nirdhan initiatives in particular. Earlier on 27 March, we had a discussion on agri-financing in the country with a team from Japan Economic Research Institute (Principal Consultant, Mr. Toshiyuki KATAGIRI and Senior Consultant, Mr. Masahito AOKI). With such knowledge exchange initiatives, we hope to contribute towards a sustainable MFI sector.

She has been availing the services since she got affiliated in Tinkunepokhari group formed by Thecho branch office of the institution in 2015. She has been trained in the business working together with her spouse. She first took a loan of NPR 60,000 and established Future Bag Industry. She shares that she has used further loan amounts of NPR 100,000 and NPR 400,000 and invested in the business.

Currently, she has an investment of about NPR 500,000 in the business. She has been producing big and small bags as per market demand. Her bags have more demand abroad than in local markets. She has been making 15 to 20 bags of different sizes daily. She has employed 3 workers in the business.

She shares on her plan of upgrading the business and Sanu Maiya Sarki was born in 1973 in an ordinary engaging additional 5 workers. She has been making family in Thangpaldhap of Sindhupalchowk district. A slight increase was noted in the coverage and outreach in terms of number of centers as well as active and loan clients during Falgun 2079 (corresponding mid-February to mid-March 2023).

The number of centres increased by 36 reaching to a total of 22,609. Likewise, the number of active clients increased by 328 reaching to a total of 403,330 and loan clients increased by 1,742 reaching to a total of 237,167.

The selected financial indicators suggested no major movement. There was slight increase in loan disbursement yet loan outstanding decreased marginally during Falgun 2079 (corresponding mid-February to mid-March 2023).

The loan disbursement reached to a volume of NPR 208.04 Billion with an increase of NPR 1.48 Billion. Likewise, loan outstanding stood at NPR 26.92 Billion and savings & deposit at NPR 18.89 Billion.

CSR/CP ACTIVITIES

Nirdhan continued with its corporate social responsibility (CSR) and client protection (CP) activities during Falgun 2079 (corresponding mid-February to mid-March 2023). Among the benefits, the maternity allowance was disbursed to the highest number of members, so far to a total of 1,799 beneficiaries amounting to NPR 3,524,000 till date in this fiscal year 2079/080.

During Falgun 2079 (corresponding mid-February to mid-March 023), Nirdhan provided maternity allowance to 248 members (total NPR 495,200), Critical Illness Relief to 33 members (total NPR 330,000) and Disaster Relief to 42 members (total NPR 159,000). Likewise, it facilitated settlement of 223 insurance claims amounting to a total of NPR 20,492,517 during the month.
